The Actors On Screen Analysis of political and non-political actors and speaking times on each station throughout 11, 12 and 13 March

1. Introducción

The Madrid bombings and their proximity in time to the end of the electoral process for the parliamentary elections conditioned the behaviour of the broadcast media. In line with the considerations made by the Catalonia Broadcasting Council (CAC) at the time into the television treatment of the attacks in Madrid of 11 March and subsequent events through to the elections of 14 March¹, both the public and private media had the duty to respect political and social pluralism in the way they acted, despite the exceptional circumstances. The Council also said that on that occasion respect for pluralism did not depend only on the content of information but also the way it was treated. That is why the Council insisted on the need to preserve the equality of conditions of access and the presence on television of the main people concerned in the news stories (actors) without any form of discrimination, respecting as much as possible news immediacy and proportionality in the way they were treated.

This article aims to examine the information on the appearance frequency and speaking time given to the actors² who intervened in the programmes (news bulletins and other programmes) of the stations TV3, TVE-1, Tele-5 and Antena 3 TV between 7.30 a.m. on 11 March and 1.30 a.m. on 14 March, to contribute towards corroborating the level of pluralism with which each station followed the stories of the events.

As defined in the article in this issue devoted to the methodology used in the abovementioned study, 'actor' was

understood to mean a person who appears on a programme and given speaking time, i.e., who makes a verbal intervention on screen. In this regard, in the case of news bulletins, actors were considered to be all the people who appeared on TV via an insert, while in the other programmes analysed, actors were considered to be all the representatives of associations, political parties and public institutions that appeared.

2. The Actors on the News Bulletins

2.1 Political and Non-Political Actors

TV3 was the only station analysed that gave more speaking time to the groups of political actors (71%) than non-political actors (29%). However, the number of inserts on the station's news bulletins referring to non-political actors (125) was higher than the number of inserts of political actors (96).

TVE-1 devoted 57.8% of the speaking time on its news bulletins to non-political actors, where the number of inserts came in at 512. This means, however, that the average speaking time per insert was lower than that of the political actors.

56.6% of the speaking time on the Tele-5 news bulletins went to non-political actors, who participated in 336 inserts. This trend was more marked on Antena 3 TV bulletins, where 67% of the speaking time went to non-political actors, who appeared on 397 separate occasions (Table 19).

2.2 The Groups of Actors with the Most Speaking Time

Between 11 and 13 March 2004, the groups of actors with the most interventions were the Spanish Government (on

TV3) and 'Others' (on the rest of the stations). It is important to remember that the latter category included all the people who were victims, relatives of victims or witnesses to the events.

After the category of 'Others', the Spanish Government was the next group with the most speaking time on the Spanish stations analysed. The third group varied according to the station: it was the Catalan Government on TV3, actors from the health sector on Tele-5, and the PP on TVE-1 and Antena 3 TV. The latter two stations coincided in the distribution of the three groups of actors given the most speaking time on their news bulletins. (Table 20).

2.3 The Groups of Political Actors

Below is the analysis of the percentage of speaking times (Table 21) and figures referring to the frequency of interventions (inserts) (Table 22) of the different groups of political actors on the news bulletins of each station.

The Spanish Government had the highest percentage of speaking time among groups of political actors on the news bulletins of all the stations analysed. It accounted for 42.9% of the time on TV3, with 23 appearances; 47.3% on TVE-1, with 36 appearances; 58.6% on Tele-5 and 37.7% on Antena 3 TV, with 26 appearances each.

In second position, TV3 gave 13.7% of the speaking time on its news bulletin to political actors from the Catalan Government (9 inserts) and 10.5% to actors from the PSOE (7 inserts). TVE-1 gave 12.2% of the speaking time to actors from the PP (4 inserts) and 11% to actors from the PSOE (5 inserts). Tele-5 gave 8.9% of the speaking time to the Crown (1 insert) and 6.4% to the PSOE (11 inserts). Finally, Antena 3 TV gave 19.6% of the speaking time to the PP (6 inserts) and 14.7% to the Crown (1 insert).

In terms of the Catalan parties, they only had a significant percentage of speaking time and a considerable number of interventions on the TV3 bulletins, the Catalan station. The PSC occupied 2.4% of the speaking time of political actors on TV3 news bulletins, with 6 appearances; CiU occupied 2.2%, with 4 appearances; the PPC, 1.8%, with 4 appearances; ERC, 1.4%, with 3 appearances, and ICV, 0.7%, with 2 appearances.

On the other stations, the presence of the groups of actors from the Catalan political system fell noticeably. TVE-1 gave

3.1% of its speaking time to CiU, which was the only representative of the Catalan party system, with 2 appearances. Catalan institutions were not given speaking time on the station's news bulletins throughout the period analysed, either.

At Tele-5, the presence of groups of Catalan political actors came in at 0.7% of the speaking time of political actors on its news bulletins, with the only appearance being from ERC. A further 0.7% went to a single appearance by the Catalan Government.

With regard to Antena 3 TV, speaking time by groups of Catalan political actors was limited to a single appearance by CiU, which occupied 1.1% of the speaking time of groups of political actors on its news bulletins. As was the case at TVE-1, Catalan institutions did not appear throughout the period analysed, except for the intervention of a single police officer from the Catalan regional police force.

Groups of political actors from the Basque political system did not receive speaking time and thus made no appearances on either the TVE-1 or Antena 3 TV news bulletins between 7.30 a.m. on 11 March and 1.30 a.m. on 14 March, despite the preliminary hypothesis of the bombings being the work of the terrorist group ETA. Furthermore, the Basque Government appeared only once on the TVE-1 and Antena 3 TV news bulletins over the period analysed.

However, Basque political groups *were* given speaking time on the other two stations analysed. At Tele-5, the PNB occupied 1.5% of the speaking time of political actors on its news bulletins, with 3 interventions, while the group Sozialista Abertzaleak was given 0.9% of the speaking time, with 1 intervention. TV3 gave speaking time to Sozialista Abertzaleak on four occasions, accounting for 1.2% of the speaking time. The PNB also intervened twice on TV3 news bulletins, accounting for 0.7% of the speaking time. With regard to the presence of political actors from Basque institutions, the President of the Basque Government appeared 5 times on TV3 news bulletins and 4 times on Tele-5 news bulletins.

These figures show that TV3 was the station that included the most diversity of inserts from the main political groups in Spain, Catalonia and the Basque Country.

For a more detailed analysis of the evolution of the percentage of speaking time given to the Spanish Government, the Catalan Government and the other party groups that took part in the 14 March elections on the news bulletins of the different stations over the three days analysed, see Tables 23, 24, 25 and 26.

2.2 Groups of Non-Political Actors: Witness Information

As I said before, the group of actors given the most speaking time on the news bulletins of the stations analysed, except for TV3, was the category 'Others'. This category included the victims of the bombings, their relatives and loved ones, as well as the occasional actors who intervened in stories to express their state of mind, experiences or support for the victims, in line with the concept of *witness information* on the news bulletins developed in a previous article in this issue of *Quaderns del CAC*³.

The category 'Others' was particularly significant in the analysis of the news bulletins, because the percentage of speaking time and number of inserts awarded to this group of actors may well be an indicator of a station's news strategy in relation to the events. In other words, a greater and more frequent presence of actors from this category could mean that the station had decided to run with a more emotional type of news treatment. News coverage based particularly on interventions by actors in this category offers a more dramatic social dimension to the events and the personal tragedies involved.

The high percentage of speaking time that the Spanish stations awarded actors from this category, possibly because of their geographical proximity to the scenes of the events, impacted their news strategy in relation to what happened.

At the beginning of this section I said that the group 'Others' accounted for most of the speaking time on the news bulletins of TVE-1, Tele-5 and Antena 3 TV, which all followed a similar news strategy in this aspect. In fact, 'Others' was also the group of non-political actors that accounted for the most interventions (inserts) and the most speaking time on the news bulletins of all the stations analysed. This group of actors occupied 13.6% of the speaking time on the TV3 news bulletins, with 77 inserts; 45% on the bulletins of TVE-1, with 414 inserts; 46.6% of those of Tele-5, with 285 inserts, and 48.4% of those of Antena 3 TV, with 312 inserts (Table 27).

3. The Actors on Other Programmes

At the end of this article, there is an appendix that includes tables with the list of interventions, in chronological order, of all the political actors and actors from the associative sector given speaking time on the programmes other than news bulletins of the stations analysed. There is also a table which lists, by station, the frequency of these actors over the period analysed.

3.1 The Groups of Actors with the Most Interventions

With regard to the appearance frequency of groups of political actors and actors from the associative sector on programmes other than news bulletins over the period analysed (from 7.30 a.m. on 11 March to 1.30 a.m. on 14 March), the Spanish Government appeared most often on all the stations analysed. It appeared 67 times on TVE-1; 45 times on TV3; 30 times on Antena 3 TV and 19 times on Tele-5.

The group of actors that accounted for the second-most appearances differed at each station analysed. At TV3 it was the group 'Non-Catalan regional administration', i.e., the groups of actors that belong to the government or administration of the other Autonomous Communities in Spain, with 19 appearances, 15 of which went to the President of the Basque Country; three to the Basque public radio and television company and one to the President of the Community of Madrid.

At TVE-1, the group of actors with the second-most appearances (17) was 'Other political actors', which covers political actors from outside Spain and the organisations of the European Union. These appearances included 5 from the President of the United States, 3 from the UN Secretary-General, 2 from the President of Mexico, 2 from the President of Colombia, one from the Prime Minister of the United Kingdom, one from the President of France, one from the President of Chile, one from the President of Peru and one from the US Secretary of State. Most of these interventions came from governments that supported the war in Iraq.

At Tele-5, the group of actors with the second-most appearances was the PSOE, with 6 appearances, while at Antena 3 TV it was the PP, with 9 appearances.

The group of actors that accounted for the third-most appearances also differed at each station analysed. At TV3, it was the Catalan Government, with 14 appearances. At TVE-1 it was representatives from the associative sector, also with 14 appearances. These were: 3 representatives from the Victims of Terrorism Association, 2 representatives from the Miguel Angel Blanco Foundation, 2 from the Platform of Professors at the University of the Basque Country (UPV), 2 from the Basta Ya movement and 1 from the Freedom Foundation. All of these associations are related to victims of ETA terrorism.

At Tele-5, the group of actors with the third-most appearances was the Crown (i.e., King Juan Carlos I), who appeared 5 times. At Antena 3 TV, it was the PSOE, with 8 interventions.

3.2 The Groups of Political Actors

The fact that the Spanish Government appeared so frequently on TVE-1 is because it set itself up as the only official source of information and the executive used the Spanish public station to satisfy the people's demands for information. However, in accordance with the CAC's considerations on this issue, it is difficult to criticise its intervention in the media, given the demands for information about who was behind the bombings, despite the impact it

might have on public opinion and people's voting behaviour. However, the Council warned of the obligation of respecting the pluralism and neutrality of information, which meant the media, particularly on the day of reflection, had to bear in mind all the main political positions and consider them in accordance with their political and social implementation⁴.

In that regard, the study prepared by the CAC's technical services department makes it possible to obtain the figures relating to the appearance frequency of the Spanish Government, the Catalan Government and the different parties in the Spanish, Catalan and Basque political systems on programmes other than news bulletins (Table 29). The appearance frequency of the Spanish parties varied according to the stations analysed. The party with the most appearances on TV3 and Tele-5 was the PSOE, with 8 and 6 inserts, respectively. The party with the most appearances on TVE-1 and Antena 3 TV was the PP, with 13 and 9 inserts, respectively.

This trend was inverted in the groups of political parties with the second-most appearances: while the PP came in second at TV3 and Tele-5, with 5 appearances on each station, the PSOE was second at TVE-1 and Antena 3 TV, with 12 and 8 appearances, respectively.

In terms of analysing the appearance frequency of Catalan

political parties, it is worth pointing out that they were basically limited to the Catalan sphere (TV3), as had happened with the news bulletins, too. At TV3, the group with the most appearances on other programmes was the Catalan Government, with 14 appearances. Then came CiU and ERC with 7 appearances each. They were followed by the PSC with 6 appearances, ICV, 5, and the PPC, 4.

The Catalan Government only appeared once on other programmes at TVE-1 over the period analysed and Catalan political institutions did not appear at all on the Spanish stations analysed. CiU was the only Catalan political party group included, once, on TVE-1 programmes. It also appeared once on Antena 3 TV.

In relation to the appearances of Basque political groups, Sozialista Abertzaleak appeared 4 times on TV3 and twice on Tele-5. TVE-1 and Antena 3 TV only included interventions from the Basque institutional political groups. TVE-1 recorded a single intervention from the President of the Basque Country, Juan José Ibarretxe, over the period analysed. Antena 3 TV included 3 inserts from the Basque leader and one from the President of the Basque Parliament. Tele-5 also included 3 appearances by the Basque leader, while TV3 included 15.

4. Conclusion

The figures analysed show that the stations' news strategies in terms of speaking time and appearance of actors was consistent at each station between news bulletins and other programmes.

The Spanish Government, consolidated as the only official source of information, was the political actor that accounted for the most speaking time on the news bulletins and the other programmes of all the stations analysed.

However, it is important to mention the pre-eminence of the group of non-political actors in terms of speaking time on the news bulletins of the Spanish stations analysed, something which marked the stations' news strategy in relation to the events, i.e., the predominance of witness information. This involved prioritising information 'from the street' over information of political analysis.

With regard to the presence of groups of political actors, there were two different informational trends, involving TVE-

1 and Antena 3 TV on the one hand, and TV3 and Tele-5 on the other.

TVE-1 and Antena 3 TV followed a similar news strategy in terms of the distribution of appearances (inserts) and speaking time of the groups of actors most frequently present on the news bulletins. They also had the same the distribution of interventions by political actors on other programmes.

With regard to Spanish parties, both stations gave more speaking time to the PP than the other party political groups. With regard to the Catalan party system, the only political party group given speaking time on TVE-1 and Antena 3 programmes was CiU. And, despite the preliminary hypothesis that the bombings were the work of the terrorist group ETA, they did not feature any interventions from Basque political party groups. TVE-1 only included one intervention from the President of the Basque Country on its news bulletins over the period analysed. The Basque Government also appeared only once on other programmes at the two stations, as well.

For their part, TV3 and Tele-5 awarded the PSOE more speaking time than the other groups in the Spanish party system. TV3 was the only station analysed that covered the interventions of all the Catalan parties with parliamentary representation. Tele-5 included one intervention from the Catalan Government and one from ERC on its news bulletins.

In terms of the interventions of the groups of Basque political actors, the two stations chose to give interventions and thus speaking time on their news bulletins to the political groups PNB and Sozialista Abertzaleak. The Basque Government also appeared more frequently on these stations, too.
